 - 3main areas relations with college: rent negotiations gone really well in the past important to keep putting in the effort, look at college does its accounting conference vs. domestic accounts and fair distribution of resources, prices for accommodation are on average increasing as refurbishment moves, so introduce discounts on rooms disrupted by this; relationship with the dean: issues with blinds at the beginning of the year, give a degree of discrepancy to the junior deans to reduce people getting deaned; work on extending opening hours of the bar in the day, good space and facilities, good place to socialise and work
 - Atmosphere of the JCR lot more transparency of the JCR budget see every meeting have outstanding budgets for people to decide about motions; open JCR up as a
